### BACKGROUND OF THE PROJECT

The Nógrád Development
Agency (HU) and the Middle-Ipel
Regional Development Ageny (SK)
started their common project in 2015 with
the objective of the establishment of cooperation
in the field of cross-border mobility.

The Hungarian-Slovakian cross-border area concerned faces the same problems on both sides: high unemployment rate, poverty and low cross-border mobility. Under the unfavourable circumstances the project partners had the initiative to explore the problems and obstacles of low labour mobility, as well as finding opportunities and solutions to promote it.

The project partners pointed out that there were not any information packages, smart guied or studies analysing and summarising relevant information and facilitating the movement of labour across the border.

### WORKSHOP I-II.

During the project we organised two workshops with the participation of Hungarian and Slovakian experts, institutions and companies involved in cross-border employment.

In the common forum the participants discussed the most typical problems of the cross-border labour market, training and education system, grants and legal background. Several ideas were raised as a basis for future cooperation to be continued in the INTERREG Slovakia-Hungary Cooperation Programme 2014-2020.





#### **CLOSING CONFERENCE**

Closing event of the project was an international conference where Hungarian, Slovakian, Polish and Czech partners were invited to.

Aim of the conference was to share the experiences collected in relation to cross-border mobility, to present the project results, as well as explore the opportunities of future cooperation. Invited experts presented the project outputs, the employment pacts launched in Hungary with the financial support of the Regional Development Operative Programme, grant schemes of the INTERREG Slovakia-Hungary Cooperation Programme with special regard to labour mobility, and finally the plans of building new bridges over the river Ipoly to increase the number of border crossing points.
